2) A self-report test, (such as the MMPI, POMS etc.) profile and a copy of those answer sheet (should we wish to rescore it)

3) The Rorschach location sheet, responses, Sequence of Scores, and Structural Summary, scored according to the Comprehensive System.

4) Any other test materials on the client (e.g., Sentence Completions, drawings, Early Memory Procedure, TAT, etc.)
